Description

Front: Kopf des Marcus Aurelius mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Fortuna sitzt nach l., in der l. Hand Füllhorn (cornucopiae) und in der r. Hand Ruder.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
