Description

Front: Kopf des Vespasianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Pax sitzt nach l. mit einem Zweig in der r. Hand und einem Mercurstab (caduceus) in der l. Hand.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
