## Description

Front: Links Kopf des Caligula nach r., gegenüber rechts Kopf des Augustus mit Strahlenkrone nach l.

Rear: Links drapierte Büste der Roma nach r., rechts ihr gegenüber drapierte Büste des Senats nach l., Zwischen ihnen die frontal stehende Statue der Athena Ilias. Oben runder Gegenstempel mit Medusenhaupt (gorgoneion).

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collection sometime bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
