Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Aemilius Aemilianus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Spes nach r. stehend, eine Blume in der r. Hand haltend und mit der l. das Gewand raffend. Beiderseits S - C.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
