## Description

Front: Kopf des Tiberius nach r.

Rear: Livia sitzt verschleiert nach r. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand eine Opferschale (patera) und mit ihrer l. ein Zepter. Beiderseits D - D / P - P.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
