Description

Rear: Nike steht nach l. gewandt. Hält in der ausgestreckten r. Hand einen Kranz.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
