## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Philippus I. in der Rückenansicht nach r.

Rear: Sechszeilige Aufschrift im Lorbeerkranz.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
