Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Constans II. mit Helm und Globus (sphaira) mit Kreuz in der r. Hand in der Vorderansicht. Im r. F. K.

Rear: Das Wertzeichen M (= 40) in der Mitte, darüber ein Kreuz. Im l. F. A/[N/A] und im r. F. [N/E/O/ς].

Overstruck: A coin or medal used as a flan to produce a new coin and that has been struck with a new die.

Clipped: Part of the rim of the coin has been removed by clipping in particular with coins made from precious metals.
