Description

A Spear with a wooden shaft and a narrow iron pike that is fixed to the shaft by means of a socket and nails. The blade is narrow, formed slightly ovally and runs out into an oblong spearhead.

The country of origin could not be determined clearly. Form and material of the spear, however, are indicative of an African origin. The museum obtained the spear from Margarete Mader, further details concerning the provenance are not known.
