Description

An arrow with a bamboo shaft and a leaf-shaped and long-stemmed iron tip. The stem resp. the tang that is put into the shaft is twisted. The shaft is provided with a notch and is above the notch, as well as for the fixation of the tip, wrapped with bast.

The object does not distinctly refer to any entry in the inventory. Therefore, the provenance is not cleared. Based on the material and the form it is probably an African arrow.
